Are you interested in leading hikes of children and sharing your passion with them about the environment? Rural Action's Environmental Education team is looking for motivated high school students to volunteer with Rural Action's Watershed Day Camps this summer. Each year Rural Action hosts two weeks of day camps where campers explore the creeks and trails of Southeastern Ohio's wild places!

Our camps are for youth between the ages of 7-12 years old. The Sunday Creek Watershed camp will be held June 6th -10th. During this week we will be exploring the creeks of Wildcat Hollow, playing around the rocks of the Hocking Hills and swimming at Burr Oak Beach. The Margaret Creek Watershed Camp will be held June 20th-24th at the Sugar Bush farm. During this week we will focus on Beavers and sustainable farming. The only requirement is that you enjoy the outdoors and want to share your love of the outdoors with the campers! Experience with working with kids, canoeing, hiking, and swimming are all positives but not required.

Camp runs from 8:30am-4:30pm and will start and end at the Rural Action office in Trimble, with transportation in between provided. Volunteers will receive free breakfast and lunch.
